

# AGRICULTURAL EMPLOYEE

## 2017-2018 Scholarship

*'Meeting Today's Challenges - - Planning for Tomorrow'*



The San Joaquin Farm Bureau Federation and SJFB Foundation for Agricultural Education will fund scholarships in the amount of \$2,000 for the 2017-2018 year. This scholarship was designed by the SJFB Foundation for Agricultural Education to be awarded to students whose parents or guardians are employed in the agricultural industry.

### Eligibility and Application Requirements

- **Parents or guardians or applicant must be employed by an agriculture operation in San Joaquin County.**
- Application *and* supporting documents must be postmarked or physically delivered to the San Joaquin Farm Bureau Federation office no later than the first Friday, March 17, 2017

- Applicant must be entering or attending an accredited junior college, four-year University, or agricultural related vocational school or program.
- Applicant must be enrolled in an undergraduate program with the major area of study being agriculture and the intentions of a career in the agricultural industry.
- Preference will be given to:
  - Applicant who or whose parent(s)' are employed directly on an agricultural operation (Farm Laborer, Packing Shed, Processing Operation, etc.).
  - Applicant parent(s)' employer is a San Joaquin Farm Bureau Member
  - Applicant whose parent(s)' are employed by the agricultural industry (PCA's, Ag Lenders, Salesman, etc.)
- Do not enclose any material other than the materials that have been requested.
- Print or type legibly.
- Official (certified) transcripts must accompany each application.
- Each application packet must be complete and submitted in its own individual envelope.

### Selection Criteria

The following will be given consideration when selecting a recipient. However, the criteria are considered cumulatively and should not be regarded as individual requirements.

- Significant financial need in order to pursue a college education.
- Demonstrated qualities: career goals, scholastic achievement, determination to succeed, leadership, desire to obtain a higher education, commitment to agriculture.
- Scholastic achievement.

### Presentation of Award / Distribution of Funds

Recipients will be presented a certificate recognizing the award at the San Joaquin Farm Bureau's 103<sup>rd</sup> Annual Meeting, tentatively scheduled for May 12, 2017. Attendance is advised.

Upon receipt of a certified transcript reflecting the recipient's enrollment as a full-time student in an accredited junior college, vocational school or four-year university, the scholarship will be funded. This documentation *must* be submitted by the college or university; unofficial copies submitted by the recipient will not be accepted.

Failure to enroll in a junior college or four-year university in the fall of 2017 may result in forfeiture of the award.
