ROSEMARIE & FRANK WOOD'S MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

As a continuing memorial to Rosemarie and Frank Woods, the Wood family has established this scholarship fund with the purpose of providing aid to students who wish to pursue careers in the agriculture industry. Up to two \$1,000.00 scholarships will be awarded annually.

Who is eligible?

Any student entering or attending an accredited four-year college or university and pursuing an education in preparation for a career in any agricultural field. Preference will be given to student's residing in San Joaquin and Stanislaus Counties.

How are recipients selected?

The Rosemarie & Frank Wood's Memorial Scholarship is awarded based on the student's recognized and demonstrated desire to pursue a career in the agriculture industry. In addition to academic performance, this award will focus on student's participation in 4-H and their career goals.

Distribution of Funds

The recipient must submit official proof of registration showing the student's full-time enrollment before funds will be disbursed. The student must also have a declared major in agriculture or a related field. This documentation must be sent directly from the recipients to the SJFB Foundation for Agricultural Education office.

A scholarship check will be sent directly to the recipient's college, which may credit the recipient's account for tuition, books, laboratory fees, or other academic costs.

Recipients will be presented with a certificate recognizing the award at the SJFB's 109th Annual Meeting on a date and time to be determined.
