



To the San Joaquin County Agricultural Community:

San Joaquin County Public Health Services (PHS) wants to extend an opportunity to assist in moving our county into the next lower tier in the COVID-19 strategy. To accomplish this quickly, the action that will produce the greatest return for our investment of time and effort is to schedule free on-site COVID-19 vaccinations.

Your Public Health Department has substantial quantities of the Pfizer, Moderna, and Johnson and Johnson vaccines available and has started an outreach vaccination program. Dr. Barfjani is coordinating the delivery of vaccines and staffing to schedule clinics locally at your farm work sites, packing sheds, and farm labor camps, or any site that best fits your specific needs. These vaccination clinics can accommodate small groups (25 or less) to large groups (up to 400+), depending upon your need and a location large enough to accommodate the number of staff to be vaccinated.

- G) Any preference of vaccine(s) to be provided.

We will provide a simple sign-up sheet gathering only the individual's name, date of birth and vaccine preference to begin the process. Once the vaccination clinic is scheduled PHS will provide all the logistics and staff (including translators) necessary to conduct the vaccination clinic from start to finish all at no cost. Those individuals requiring a second dose of the vaccine to complete the immunization process will be given a specific date, time, and location for the second dosage as part of the initial vaccination.

It is anticipated that it will take approximately 30 minutes total for each individual to complete the vaccination process. We will coordinate scheduling of staff to receive the vaccine to assist you in maintaining work operations.

Please do strongly consider scheduling vaccination clinics for those who wish to receive the vaccine and as a measure to lessen the economic impact to our county. We await your contact to schedule these important vaccination events.
