

Robert J. Cabral Memorial Junior College Scholarship

As a continuing memorial to Robert J. Cabral, the Cabral family has established the Robert J. Cabral Memorial Scholarship Fund with the purpose of providing aid to students who wish to pursue careers in the agriculture or education industries. One \$1,000.00 scholarship will be awarded annually.

Mr. Cabral was instrumental in organizing the SJFB scholarship program. Along with the active guidance and participation of the Cabral Family, the SJFB Foundation for Agricultural Education, a non-profit educational organization, now administers the scholarship.

- ♦ Who is eligible?

Any student entering or attending San Joaquin Delta College or Modesto Junior College and pursuing a career in any agricultural or educational field.

- ♦ How are recipients selected?

The Robert J. Cabral Memorial Junior College Scholarship is awarded based on the student's recognized and demonstrated desire to pursue a career in the agriculture or education industries. Although academic performance will be considered, awards will be given to students based on their career goals, their demonstrated leadership abilities, and their commitment to succeed.

- ♦ Distribution of Funds

The recipient must submit proof of registration showing the student's full-time enrollment before funds will be disbursed. A scholarship check will be sent directly to the recipient's college, which may credit the recipient's account for tuition, books, laboratory fees, or other academic costs.

Recipients will be presented with a certificate recognizing the award at the SJFB's Scholarship Awards Ceremony which will be held at the San Joaquin Farm Bureau's Annual Meeting. - ♦ Applications submitted without ALL of the request documentation will not be considered in the selection process
- ♦ *Do not enclose or attach any documents other than the required attachments.*
