The Henry & Angelina Long Memorial Scholarship Fund was established by their family to provide aid to a student pursuing a college degree leading to a career in the agriculture industry.

Mr. Long was the third generation of an over 100-year farming legacy. His lifelong commitment to agriculture and community service led him to serve on the boards of numerous organizations, including the San Joaquin Farm Bureau for over 50 years. He received recognition throughout his life for his many contributions to agriculture, including induction into the San Joaquin County Agricultural Hall of Fame in 2012.

Mrs. Long was deeply rooted in agriculture, growing up on her family's dairy farm before establishing a lifelong farming partnership with her husband, Henry, in French Camp. She was active in agricultural organizations including the San Joaquin Farm Bureau, California Women for Agriculture, and the French Camp 4-H Club, where she served as a longtime project leader. Her dedication to farming and community left a lasting legacy for future generations.

Awarding the scholarship is contingent on acceptance and enrollment in a two- or four-year college and a complete application, including an essay demonstrating the applicant's passion for agriculture. The scholarship is a grant, and recipients are encouraged to use their education and future careers to give back to their communities.

Under the guidance and participation of the Reece family, The Henry & Angelina Long Memorial Scholarship is administered by the SJFB Foundation for Agricultural Education, a non-profit educational organization. Each year the family will graciously give a \$1,000 scholarship to the deserving candidate.

Eligibility Requirements

• Applicants must be entering or attending an accredited junior college or four-year university in California with a majority of their study in agriculture.

Application Requirements

- Application and supporting documentation must be postmarked or physically delivered to the San Joaquin Farm Bureau Federation Office no later than Friday, March 27, 2026, by 4:00 pm. Mail / Deliver to 3290 N. Ad Art Road, Stockton, California 95215
- One letter of recommendation must accompany the application.
- A one-page essay must accompany the application.
- Transcripts must accompany the application.
- Print or type legibly.
- Applications submitted without ALL requested documents will not be considered for selection.
- Do not include any material other than the materials that have been requested.

Selection Criteria

- Demonstrated desire and commitment to pursue a career in the agricultural industry.
- Demonstrated need for financial assistance to fulfill educational goals.

Distribution of Funds

Recipients will be presented with a certificate recognizing the award at the SJFB's Scholarship Awards Ceremony which will be held At San Joaquin Farm Bureau's Annual Meeting. *The date and location are to be determined.*

- Upon receipt of a certified document reflecting the recipient's enrollment as a full-time student in a junior college or four-year university, the scholarship check will be sent to the recipient's college, which can be used for tuition, books, or other academic costs.
- Failure to enroll in a junior college or university in the fall of 2026 will result in forfeiture of the award. Unless special consideration has been made by the SJFB Foundation and Wunsch Family.
