BRUCE AND BARBARA METTLER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

As a continuing memorial to Bruce and Barbara Mettler, the San Joaquin Farm Bureau has partnered with the Mettler family and established the Bruce and Barbara Mettler Scholarship Fund with the purpose of providing aid to students who wish to pursue careers in the agriculture industry. One \$1,000.00 scholarship will be awarded annually.

Who is eligible?

Any student entering or attending an accredited four-year college, university, or graduate program, and pursuing a career in any agricultural field and that has been involved in their community. Students entering a junior college are not eligible for this scholarship.

• How are recipients selected?

The Bruce and Barbara Mettler Memorial Agricultural Scholarship is awarded based on the student's recognized and demonstrated desire to pursue a career in the agriculture industry. In addition to academic performance, these awards will focus on students who have demonstrated a clear understanding of the importance of community service.

Distribution of Funds

A scholarship check will be sent directly to the recipient's college, which may credit the recipient's account for tuition, books, laboratory fees, or other academic costs.

Recipients will be presented with a certificate recognizing the award at the SJFB's Scholarship Awards Ceremony which will be held at the San Joaquin Farm Bureau's Annual Meeting. *The date and location are to be determined.*

Upon receipt of the recipient's enrollment as a full-time student in an accredited junior college, vocational school or four-year university, the scholarship will be funded directly to the recipient. Failure to enroll in a junior college or four-year university in the fall of 2026 may result in forfeiture of the award.

- Two current letters of recommendation must accompany the application.

- Where applicable, documentation of SAT and/or ACT scores must be attached.
- Applications submitted without ALL of the request documentation will not be considered in the selection process
- Do not enclose or attach any documents other than the required attachments.
