'Meeting Today's Challenges - Planning for Tomorrow'

The San Joaquin Farm Bureau Federation will fund scholarships in the amount of \$2,000 for the 2026 year. The purpose of this scholarship is not

only to reward those who have demonstrated a commitment to agriculture, but also to secure a viable future for the agriculture industry by funding the education of tomorrow's leaders. San Joaquin Farm Bureau offers two scholarship categories please review the Eligibility and Application Requirements of both carefully to ensure you are completing the correct application.

Eligibility and Application Requirements

Parents or guardians of the applicant must be a <u>current voting member</u> of the San Joaquin Farm Bureau Federation. Voting members include Agricultural and Business members (Associate and Collegiate members do not qualify; Grandparents or other relatives do not fulfill the membership requirement.) *Please call SIFB (209) 931-4931 to verify your membership category if you are unsure.

- Application and supporting documents must be postmarked or physically delivered to the San Joaquin Farm Bureau Federation office no later than Friday, March 27, 2026 by 4:00 pm. Mail / Deliver to: 3290 N. Ad Art Road, Stockton, CA 95215
- Applicant must be entering or attending an accredited junior college, four-year University, or agricultural related vocational school or program.
- Applicant must be enrolled in an undergraduate or postgraduate program with the major area of study being agriculture and the intentions of a career in the agricultural industry.
- Do not enclose any material other than the materials that have been requested.
- Print or type legibly.
- Transcripts must accompany each application.
- Each application packet must be complete and submitted in its own individual envelope.

Selection Criteria

The following will be given consideration when selecting a recipient. However, the criteria are considered cumulatively and should not be regarded as individual requirements.

- Demonstrated qualities: career goals, scholastic achievement, determination to succeed, leadership, desire to obtain a higher education, commitment to agriculture.
- Difficulty and achievement level of academic courses.
- College entrance exam scores.

Presentation of Award / Distribution of Funds

Recipients will be presented with a certificate recognizing the award at the SJFB's Scholarship Awards Ceremony which will be held at the SJFB Annual Meeting. *The date and location are to be determined.*

Upon receipt of the recipient's enrollment as a full-time student in an accredited junior college or four-year university, the scholarship will be funded directly to the recipient.

Failure to enroll in a junior college or four-year university in the fall of 2026 may result in forfeiture of the award.
