ROSEMARIE & FRANK WOOD'S MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

As a continuing memorial to Rosemarie and Frank Woods, the Wood family has established this scholarship fund with the purpose of providing aid to students who wish to pursue careers in the agriculture industry. Up to two \$1,000.00 scholarships will be awarded annually.

• Who is eligible?

Any student entering or attending an accredited four-year college or university for undergraduate or postgraduate studies and pursuing an education in preparation for a career in any agricultural field. Preference will be given to student's residing in San Joaquin and Stanislaus Counties.

How are recipients selected?

The Rosemarie & Frank Wood's Memorial Scholarship is awarded based on the student's recognized and demonstrated desire to pursue a career in the agriculture industry. In addition to academic performance, this award will focus on student's participation in 4-H and their career goals.

• Distribution of Funds

Recipients will be presented with a certificate recognizing the award at the SJFB's Scholarship Awards Ceremony which will be held at the SJFB Annual Meeting. *The date and location are to be determined.*

Upon receipt of the recipient's enrollment as a full-time student in an accredited junior college or four-year university, the scholarship will be funded directly to the recipient. Failure to enroll in a junior college or four-year university in the fall of 2026 may result in forfeiture of the award.

A scholarship check will be sent directly to the recipient's college, which may credit the recipient's account for tuition, books, laboratory fees, or other academic costs.
