

## San Joaquin Farm Bureau Young Farmers & Ranchers

2026 Scholarship

YOUNG FARMERS & RANCHERS

The San Joaquin Young Farmers & Ranchers will fund a minimum of \$5,000 in scholarships ranging from \$1,000-\$2,500 for the 2026-2027 school year. High school and college student applications will be reviewed separately; a minimum of one scholarship will be awarded to a high school student and a minimum of one scholarship will be awarded to a college student. The purpose of this scholarship is not only to reward those who have demonstrated a commitment to agriculture, but also to secure a viable future for the agriculture industry by funding the education of tomorrow's leaders.

San Joaquin Farm Bureau Young Farmers & Ranchers are active agriculturists like you - between the ages of 18 and 35 and involved in production, banking, business, and many other areas of the industry. Young Farmers & Ranchers develop leadership skills while volunteering time as active, vital members of Farm Bureau.

#### Eligibility and Application Requirements

Application *and* supporting documents must be postmarked or physically delivered to the San Joaquin Farm Bureau Federation office no later than the close of business on Friday, March 27, 2026, by 4:00 pm. Mail / Deliver to: 3290 N. Ad Art Road, Stockton, CA 95215

- Applicants must be entering or attending an accredited junior college or four-year University, enrolled in an undergraduate program and major area of study must be agriculture or related field.
- Do not enclose any material other than the materials that have been requested.
- Print or type legibly.
- Transcripts must accompany each application. If you are a Freshman in college, please also include your high school transcript.
- Each application packet must be complete and submitted in its own individual envelope.

#### Selection Criteria

The following will be given consideration when selecting a recipient. However, the criteria are considered cumulatively and should not be regarded as individual requirements.

- Demonstrated qualities: career goals, scholastic achievement, determination to succeed, leadership, desire to obtain a higher education, commitment to agriculture.
- Difficulty and achievement level of academic courses.
- Future plans for involvement in the agriculture industry.

#### Presentation of Award / Distribution of Funds

Recipients will be presented with a certificate recognizing the award at the SJFB's Scholarship Awards Ceremony which will be held at the SJFB Annual Meeting. *The date and location are to be determined.* 

Upon receipt of the recipient's enrollment as a full-time student in an acredited junior college or four-year university, the scholarship will be funded directly to the recipient. In addition, San Joaquin Farm Bureau Young Farmers & Ranchers will process and pay for one year of Collegiate Farm Bureau membership for each recipient.

Failure to enroll in a junior college or four-year university in the fall of 2026 may result in forfeiture of the award.
